Peach Tree has introduced a dynamite new product, the Grand Integrated. The Grand Integrated is essentially four superb components built onto one chassis.



### Power Amp

This integrated amp starts life with a GIGUNDO 400x2 power amp built in! Now here's a great start!

With 440x2 you have enough power to handle literally ANY speaker you'll ever own! While most companies spend time talking about the romance of their sound, they often come up short in terms of good old horse power. Grand Integrated leaves that question in the dust.

I warmed up the Grand Integrated on some hungry Magnepans where it produces over 650 w/ch! Holy impact and dynamic range! Those 3.7s just jumped up and danced!

### Preamp

Next, the Grand Integrated has a fine high level preamp built in. You can listen through the solid state section or the built in tube (two 12AU7s) option! The choice is yours. It does have a preamp out so you can add a sub or another amplifier. Also has HT input.

### DAC

Grand Integrated has an edge of the art Sabre DAC on board, ideal for cleaning up the jitter your computer, Sonos, Apple TV or even CD transport throw its way. Inputs include USB, Two Coax and Two OPTs.

### Headphone Amp

You late night listeners and young parents (and grandparents) have not been forgotten!
