Tivoli's Model One (\$150) AM-FM Table Radio has been a standard in kitchens around the country for years. But Henry Kloss (Tivoli's tuner designer) was a sly dog. He created a STEREO output on Model One so you can run it into your fancy hifi! Why would you want to do that?



First of all, the FM reception is surprisingly good. It finds and holds stations well.

The bigger surprise is, the AM section is a cut above.

Why would I care?

Packers.

Brewers.

Fact is, the AM performance of almost any tuner out there is a throw in. It is so full of noise and debris that is virtually unlistenable through a nice hifi.

Sonos is a great radio solution but you can't listen to sporting events without paying.
